**II. Read the text and do Task 2 and Task 3 below.****Olympics: Travel agencies cash in on London Games**

SHANGHAI: As athletes make their final preparations and jet off to London for the Olympic Games which open on Friday, Chinese travellers are doing the same, and travel agencies are cashing in by offering various experiences.

However, they don't come cheap. Travel agencies are designing new experiences for Chinese travellers to soak up their passion of the Olympics. A seven-day tour around London, which includes tickets to three event finals, is priced at over US\$11,000.

Tang Qing, product manager, Caissa Touristic, said: "The products cater to the preferences of the Chinese customers and include competitions which the China team has better odds of winning. For instance, badminton, table tennis and diving are some of the traditional strengths of China. In addition, we will also recommend that customers watch competitions that are more aesthetic, such as rhythmic gymnastics and synchronized swimming."

Despite the high price, demand is strong. Boosted by the Olympic fever, revenue for London travel at this agency has increased seven times, compared to a year ago.

For something even more upmarket, the travel company has come up with a premium tour, so travellers can live, dine and socialise like British royalty. The week-long tour package costs US\$25,000 and includes dinner at an exclusive club, private shopping, or lunch at London's Louis Vuitton flagship store with a fashion show featuring its latest collection thrown in.

From air tickets to hotel accommodation to car rental, prices for London travel have at least doubled during this period. Most hotels are fully booked. Because of the high price and limited capacity, many Chinese travel agencies are turning to post-Olympics business opportunities. (*Adapted from www.channelnewsasia.com 26 July 2012*)
